DIRECTIONS

From I-80 westbound (Stroudsburg area)

From I-80 west, exit 307 Broad Street.
Turn left off the ramp onto Route 191 south.
At the stop sign, go straight up and over the hill
on Route 191 south. *

*Turn right on Cherry Valley Road (your turn will be in 1 mile, at the bottom of the hill.)
It is exactly, 1.7 miles to the distribution center (little white building with green trim).

From I-80 eastbound (Stroudsburg area)

From I-80 east, exit 307 Park Avenue.
Turn right off the ramp onto Route 611 south.
In less than 1 mile, turn right onto Route 191 south. *

From Route 33 northbound (from Allentown area)

From 33 North, exit Saylorsburg. Turn left off the ramp onto Cherry Valley Rd. Continue straight on Cherry Valley Road for 5.1 miles to the village of Stormsville. You then have a choice of going up a steep hill or bearing off to the right. Bear off to the right, and travel 8/10 of a mile, past 2 horse farms on the right. After the next farmhouse on the right (with red barns), our driveway is the next on the right for the distribution center (little white building with green trim).
